


COVERNHAM RESERVOIR & LOUTH CANAL



This steady circular walk takes in two expanses of water: the Covenham Reservoir, the largest stretch of inland water in Lincolnshire, and a section of the old Louth Canal, a twelve mile inland waterway dug to connect Louth to the Humber, south of Grimsby.

It starts in the village of Fulstow, which sits on the meridian
